Can you put solar panels on a flat roof?

Yes, in the majority of cases you can put solar PV panels on a flat roof without any issues. Most modern buildings in the UK now have flat roofs, and it's possible to install solar panels on them. However, there are some differences between solar systems on flat roofs versus sloped roofs.

Should solar panels be flat?

Solar panels should not be flat because they can collect water, which will build up on the surface and damage the solar cells. So, it is much better to angle them; not too much - as little as three to four degrees tilt will ensure that rainwater continually glides off the surface if you have a flat roof.

Do you need planning permission to install solar panels on a flat roof?

Thanks to recent changes to permitted development rules, most installations on flat roofs won't need solar panel planning permission. So long as the panels aren't visible from the street and don't exceed 200mm above the roof, they should be covered under permitted development rights.

Can a flat roof damage a solar panel system?

Flat roofs can quickly accumulate standing water, damaging your solar panel system. You'll need proper drainage to prevent water from pooling around the solar panels. You'll also need a tilted mounting system to allow the rain to fall away from the surface of the solar panels instead of collecting on the flat surface.

Are flat roof solar panels more expensive?

Because of this, flat roof solar panels can often be more expensive. Of course, the price still varies depending on your circumstances. On the plus side, it's safer and simpler to set up than solar panels on sloped roofs as you don't need the same level of equipment to install them.

How far apart should solar panels be on a flat roof?

However, as a general rule of thumb, you need about one metre between each row of solar panels on a flat roof. Building and safety regulations also require a minimum distance of 0.5-1m between the solar panels and the edge of the roof. Where is the best place to put solar panels on a roof?
