Is the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic a de facto state?

The Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic (SADR) is a unique example of a de facto state- having existed for almost 50 years and enjoying international recognition provided by over forty states. Nevertheless, it controls only one-fifth of the territory it claims rights to, while the rest of it lies within the Moroccan borders.

Is Sahrawi a state?

The Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic, [e] also known as the Sahrawi Republic and Western Sahara, is a partially recognized state, located in the western Maghreb, which claims the non-self-governing territory of Western Sahara, but controls only the easternmost one-fifth of that territory. It is recognized by 44 UN member states and South Ossetia.

Who recognizes the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic?

The Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic is recognized by the African Union and, as of December 2022, by 47 U.N. member states, as well as another de facto state, South Ossetia.

What is the Sahrawi people's Liberation Army?

The Sahrawi People's Liberation Army is the defence force of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic and previously served as the armed wing of the Polisario Front prior to the foundation of the Republic.

Who is the president of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic?

Since August 1982, the highest office of the republic has been the President of the Sahrawi Arab Democratic Republic, a post held by the secretary-general of the Polisario Front, presently Brahim Ghali, [17] who appoints the Prime Minister, presently Bouchraya Hammoudi Bayoun.

Is the Polisario Front a legitimate representative of the Sahrawi people?

The UN considers the Polisario Front to be the legitimate representative of the Sahrawi people, and maintains that the people of Western Sahara have a right to "self-determination and independence". [13]
