Why are Chinese solar panel manufacturers seeking a government intervention?

REUTERS/Stringer/File Photo Purchase Licensing Rights SHANGHAI, June 12 (Reuters) - Chinese solar panel manufacturers said they are seeking immediate government intervention to curb investment and industry collaboration to arrest a plunge in prices of solar cells and modules, as the industry faces overcapacity.

Why are China's solar companies undercutting each other?

China's world-dominating solar firms have been forced to sell below cost after a breakneck buildup in capacity to feed China's renewables boom. Companies are undercutting each other to maintain market share, and most are expected to report losses this year, BloombergNEF said in a report earlier this month.

Will China become the world's largest solar panel manufacturer?

Financial incentives and a government push have helped China become the solar panel factory of the world, accounting for about 80% of global module capacity. Analysts expect Chinese manufacturers to add up to 600 gigawatts (GW) this year, enough to meet global demand through 2032.

Can China's solar industry go wrong?

China's solar industry can go one of two ways, according to Jin at S&P Global. Companies can either collaborate and self-regulate, which would allow them to maintain prices and earn modest profits while gradually tackling excess capacity, or if they engage in a price war and keep building new factories, things can go wrong really fast, she said.

How many solar panels can China produce a year?

As a result, Chinese companies now account for more than 80 per cent of the global PV manufacturing capacity. They have a capacity to produce around 1,200 GW of panels a year, double the global demand in 2024 and more than the world's installation forecast in 2030.

Will competition drive China's solar panels into bankruptcy?

However, with no end in sight for the plunge in prices, industry officials and analysts said intense competition was threatening to drive smaller producers into bankruptcy. Rapid capacity additions drove down prices of China's finished solar panels by 42% last year.
