Should I replace my car battery?

Do battery problems mean it needs to be replaced?

The most important thing to be aware of is that battery problems DON'T necessarily mean it needs replacing. It may simply need charging, and there be some simple things you can do to resolve the issue.

Don't wait for your car to give you the silent treatment before you check or replace your battery. Regular checks and understanding the signs of battery failure are crucial to ensuring your vehicle remains reliable. If you're unsure about your battery's condition after a DIY test, it's wise to consult a professional.

Should I replace my battery if it's over 4 years old?

If your battery is over 4 years old we'd advise replacing it with a new one. You may find you're able to temporarily recharge a battery this old, however it's likely to lose its charge again very soon. Older batteries do deteriorate over time and naturally lose their ability to hold a charge.

Do old car batteries deteriorate over time?

Older batteries do deteriorate over time and naturally lose their ability to hold a charge. Even old batteries in need of replacement can provide enough power to start a car when they're charged. Signs that your battery is reaching the end of its life are often found in electronic features they aren't functioning as normal.

How do I know if my car battery needs replacing?

Note: for this method to work, you must have a battery tester that can perform a battery capacity test, not just a battery voltage test.
