How do you dispose of a battery in the UK?

The battery must be surrounded by the inert material (sand or specialised silica). Avoid disposing of damaged batteries in general waste or recycling containers. In the UK, there are additional legal obligations on batteries from the Batteries & Accumulators (placing on the market) regulations 2008.

Does a waste lead acid battery contain Pops?

This guidance applies to waste automotive, industrial and portable lead acid batteries. It does not apply to other types of waste battery. The plastic cases of waste lead acid batteries may contain persistent organic pollutants (POPs). You can identify if a waste lead acid battery may contain POPs by checking: Where the battery case is made of :

Are lithium batteries hazardous waste?

At the moment, Lithium batteries are not classified as hazardous waste by the Hazardous Waste Regulations 2005. Lithium metal is, however, mentioned in the Environment Agency's guidance on hazardous waste (WM3) as a substance whose presence could render a waste hazardous on account of its flammability.
