

How to remove the battery if the power button is broken

What if my power button is broken?

A broken power button complicates things. Fortunately, you don't need to buy a new phone just because your power button is broken; you can turn your Android off and on without a power button, using various workarounds. This article teaches you how to turn on and off your Android phone if the power button has stopped working.

How do you turn on a phone if the power button is broken?

One of the simplest methods is to connect your phone to a charger. Many smartphones will automatically power on when plugged in. If your phone has some battery left, connecting it to a charger may wake it up even if the power button is broken. Wait a few moments to see if the phone turns on by itself.

What happens if a power button is broken on Android?

Your Android uses the power button to turn the phone on and to turn it off. A broken power button complicates things. Fortunately, you don't need to buy a new phone just because your power button is broken; you can turn your Android off and on without a power button, using various workarounds.

How to turn off a phone without a power button?

Go to Settings and tap the search box. Type "schedule" in the search box and select Schedule power on/off. You can set the power on and off time to make your phone turn on and off automatically without the power button.

6. Turn off and Restart Device Using ADB Commands

You can use an ADB command to restart or turn off your phone.

How to restart Android phone without power button?

Once in the Recovery Mode, you will see the option to reboot the phone. Tap on it to power on your phone normally. If that option is not visible, simply exit the Recovery Mode and your phone should start up. If the above methods do not work, you will have to rely on the Fastboot Mode to turn on your Android phone without the power button.

How do I Reboot my Android phone if the power button fails?

Open a command prompt or terminal on your computer. Type the command `adb devices` to ensure your phone is recognised. Enter the command `adb reboot` to turn on your phone. This method requires prior setup of USB debugging, so it's only effective if the feature was enabled before the power button malfunctioned.

This can be the battery, or this can be the power button. To test to see if this is the button causing the problem, you should try plugging your phone into a wall charger. ... you probably have a "broken" power button. Proceed below! ... There will be two on one side (volume buttons) and one on the other (power button). Remove the component ...

Remove the battery(if you have the removable version). Or just open it any time. The battery is already powering things even when it's fully drained. And 12 volts wont shock you. Open the laptop and remove the keyboard and the metal that covers the power button. Check for replacement ones on ebay.
