

# How to remove the battery of the desktop power supply

How do you remove a power supply from a computer?

Press the power button to discharge any remaining power in the system. Remove the computer cover. Disconnect the power cables from the system board and any internal devices. Remove the screws securing the power supply to the chassis. Press the power supply clamp to release it from the chassis. Slide the power supply from the system.

How do you remove a power supply from a case?

Remove the screws that hold your power supply unit in the case. You'll typically find two to four screws, so take them off and set them aside safely. Pull your old power supply out of your case after unplugging and unscrewing all the connections. If your case comes with a PSU shroud or an enclosure, you must remove it to take the PSU out.

How do you replace a power supply?

Slide the power supply in until the power supply clamp latches in to place. Replace the screws securing the power supply to the chassis. Reconnect the power cables to the system board and the internal devices and drives. Replace the cover, and reconnect the power and other external cables. You have successfully replaced your power supply.

How do I fix a dead power supply?

Connect the PSU to your main fan (the biggest one) and as many other ones as your connection supports. Put your computer's side back on, fasten the screws and try out your new power supply. Can the power supply be fixed if it is dead?

How do I install a new power supply unit?

Assuming you have the new power supply unit ready for installation, follow the steps highlighted below to get it up and running: Start by inserting the PSU into the exact position of the old unit. You may have to take out the PSU shroud or the enclosure and drop the PSU in it if your PC case comes with one.

How do you remove a power supply from a chassis?

Remove the screws securing the power supply to the chassis. Press the power supply clamp to release it from the chassis. Slide the power supply from the system. Slide the power supply in until the power supply clamp latches in to place. Replace the screws securing the power supply to the chassis.

Remove one 8IP screw from the power supply grounding bracket. Grip both sides of the power supply and pull it out. Install the new power supply. Insert the new power supply in the bottom slot. Push firmly and evenly until the power supply is fully seated. Reinstall the 8IP screw back into the power supply grounding bracket.
