Unless there is a valid reason to state otherwise, permission for the installation should be granted. In some conservation areas (such as historical ones), it may be requested that you use solar roof tiles instead of panels.

Are solar panels allowed on a property?

Certain conditions must be met for permitted development rights for solar panels which include: Panels must not protrude more than 200mm from the roof. This helps to protect the appearance of the building. The solar panels must not affect the structure of the roof or the appearance of the property.

What happens if you install solar panels without planning permission?

If you install solar panels without the necessary planning permission or in breach of regulations, you could face several legal and financial consequences, including the removal of your panels, fines, legal action, compromised insurance policies, and personal risks such as to your safety and diminished property value.
