How do I know if my Li-ion battery is low?

Press the button on the battery and the LEDs will light up green for around five seconds, then indicate the charge level. If only one LED flashes green, the battery level is low. The green LEDs also indicate the charge level while the Li-ion battery is in a charging station (if no LEDs are lit, the charging process is complete).

What happens when you charge a lithium ion battery?

When charging a lithium-ion battery, both the battery and charging station continue to exchange data: when the charge level reaches 80%, the charger continues charging but automatically switches to a very low, gentle charging rate.

How do you know if a lithium ion battery is fully charged?

When it comes to lithium-ion batteries, understanding the state of charge based on voltage alone is a bit like trying to find your way in the dark without a flashlight. Sure, you know if you're fully charged at 4.2 volts or empty at the low voltage cutoff around 2.8 volts, but the journey between these two points? That's where it gets murky.

What does a battery charging light mean?

Yellow- The yellow lights indicate that the battery is currently being charged. Green - When the battery is fully charged, the light usually turns green, indicating that the battery is ready for use. It is important to refer to the user manual for your specific charger to understand the meaning of the charging lights.
