

Where can I recycle old batteries?

This means there are now lots more places where you can take your old batteries for recycling. If you can't see a collection box, ask a shop assistant if they have one - sometimes they keep it behind the counter.

Can you recycle a battery?

Reduce fire risk and save precious resources by recycling your batteries. Common household batteries include lithium-ion button batteries from watches, hearing aids, etc, as well as standard barrel-type batteries (AAs, AAAs and so on). You must recycle these household batteries at dedicated battery collection points.

Where can I recycle AA batteries?

From February 2010, shops selling more than 32kg of batteries a year (approx 345 x four-packs of AA batteries) have to provide battery recycling collection bins in store. This means there are now lots more places where you can take your old batteries for recycling.

How do you recycle rechargeable batteries?

The Call2Recycle programme has over 34,000 recycling spots for rechargeable batteries. It's a big help for people to recycle their batteries properly. This helps make our planet greener. Local councils also have online recycling guides.

Where can I recycle car batteries in the UK?

In the UK you can recycle car batteries at designated collection points. These includes many household waste recycling centres, garages and scrap yards. Or, if a specialist is replacing your car battery, they might be able to dispose of the old one safely for you. Where should I go to recycle batteries?

What is battery recycling?

Battery recycling ensures the recovery of these materials and prevents any potentially harmful effects on both the environment and human health. We want to make it easier for everyone to recycle their batteries. Speak with our colleagues who will help place these in our correct bins. This service can be used even if no purchase is made.

**Battery Recycling Location.** Where you can recycle batteries will vary depending on your location and state and local laws for disposal of batteries.
