

# Research on the ratio of positive electrode materials for lithium batteries

Do lithium-ion batteries have positive electrodes?

After an introduction to lithium insertion compounds and the principles of Li-ion cells, we present a comparative study of the physical and electrochemical properties of positive electrodes used in lithium-ion batteries (LIBs).

What are the recent trends in electrode materials for Li-ion batteries?

This mini-review discusses the recent trends in electrode materials for Li-ion batteries. Elemental doping and coatings have modified many of the commonly used electrode materials, which are used either as anode or cathode materials. This has led to the high diffusivity of Li ions, ionic mobility and conductivity apart from specific capacity.

Can lithium insertion materials be used as positive or negative electrodes?

It is not clear how one can provide the opportunity for new unique lithium insertion materials to work as positive or negative electrode in rechargeable batteries. Amatucci et al. proposed an asymmetric non-aqueous energy storage cell consisting of active carbon and  $\text{Li}[\text{Li}_{1/3}\text{Ti}_{5/3}]\text{O}_4$ .

Can lithium metal be used as a negative electrode?

Lithium metal was used as a negative electrode in  $\text{LiClO}_4$ ,  $\text{LiBF}_4$ ,  $\text{LiBr}$ ,  $\text{LiI}$ , or  $\text{LiAlCl}_4$  dissolved in organic solvents. Positive-electrode materials were found by trial-and-error investigations of organic and inorganic materials in the 1960s.

How do anode and cathode electrodes affect a lithium ion cell?

The anode and cathode electrodes play a crucial role in temporarily binding and releasing lithium ions, and their chemical characteristics and compositions significantly impact the properties of a lithium-ion cell, including energy density and capacity, among others.

Which positive electrode materials are used in Li-ion batteries?

This paper deals with the advantages and disadvantages of the positive electrode materials used in Li-ion batteries: layered  $\text{LiCoO}_2$  (LCO),  $\text{LiNi}_y\text{Mn}_y\text{Co}_{1-2y}\text{O}_2$  (NMC), spinel  $\text{LiMn}_2\text{O}_4$  (LMO),  $\text{LiMn}_{1.5}\text{Ni}_{0.5}\text{O}_4$  (LMN) and olivine  $\text{LiFePO}_4$  (LFP) materials.
