Can you recycle a battery?

Reduce fire risk and save precious resources by recycling your batteries. Common household batteries include lithium-ion button batteries from watches, hearing aids, etc, as well as standard barrel-type batteries (AAs, AAAs and so on). You must recycle these household batteries at dedicated battery collection points.

Can you dispose of car batteries in a rubbish bin?

By law you mustn't dispose of car batteries in a rubbish bin. In the UK you can recycle car batteries at designated collection points. These includes many household waste recycling centres, garages and scrap yards. Or, if a specialist is replacing your car battery, they might be able to dispose of the old one safely for you.

How do I dispose of my home-generated batteries?

Note: If the container is empty, you may dispose of it using a regular trash receptacle. UC employees should take their home-generated batteries to their community recycling center rather than disposing of them on campus. Can you put batteries in a waste bin?

WRWA would like to remind residents that they should not put their batteries in a waste bin, recycling sack or wheely bin. Loose batteries, or electricals with batteries hidden inside, do need to be recycled separately. You'll find advice on where you can drop them off on our website.
